The 10-6 record the wrestlers compiled in the 1974-75 season is only a set of meaningless numbers if everything that was put into the season is forgotten.


What does a team's record mean anyway?


Does it only show how good the team is in comparison with other teams? No one ever enters into the record the long hours of physical work involved in practices; the esteem and


respect gained from doing the best job possible; the unity, fellowship and trust team members hold for one another.







